## **RCM Report June 2026**

I attended the Regional Conference in May and also attended the Multi area conference workgroup. The following is my report from the attendance of both of these events.

The regional gave two really great workshops on RCM basics workshop and Predatory behavior. They have forwarded these workshops to us. If anyone is interested in receiving these workshops please let us know and we will be more than happy to present them.

There was open discussion about concerns of the convention. One being that one certain sponsorship family was running it, another being that there were several decisions made that were independent of the entire CAC and it was stated that it was the last Lonestar convention without this being voted at the BOD. There was also concern from other members that amounts of merchandise were cut right before the convention. This was discussed.

Area reports were given. Fort Worth had a concern that an idea from Texarkana did not follow consensus. The facilitator disagreed, discussion proceeded and it was decided it was not understood enough to follow through and it was left as it was.

It was agreed that SZF and world would receive half of allotted donations. This will be 916.66 each to them.

RSO BOD chair was present and read a report and advised they are no longer willing to host the convention and have not discussed as to whether they will turn over the convention to the Region. It was asked by East Texas how much was the hotel bill, what will be done with the remaining money after the convention expenses, what will be done if restitution is received from the embezzlement case, what is the rent on the storage unit they are no longer willing to pay for and what is in the storage unit.

Hotel bill is included in Convention treasurer report

Have not decided about where money will be distributed on any of the questions asked about finances

The storage unit during this question was picked up by two members and will be paid by them for two months and the cost is 135.00 a month, and they do not have an inventory of what is in the storage unit. A request was made to have an inventory.

The co-Chair of the BOD then reported when asked if property and money would be returned to the region that the BOD is still willing to serve as they have with the management of the convention. He also stated that the BOD has no assets. The body

needs to decide soon whether they want the BOD to manage the convention or not. They stated that the BOD still has legal obligations and that the NAWs debt has not been paid yet and that they will make a decision to pay that at the next BOD meeting. Note to that, they did vote to pay that at their meeting. They also stated that the hotel has new ownership and they will have to have a credit card on file and 30,000 in savings. This was decided to send back to areas.

The regional workshop reported that they had met and questions were sent out for areas and groups to respond to. I have forwarded them through the email but copies are provided if you did not receive them. Please take them back to your groups for review and bring them back to next area with the answers. Any questions please let me know.

Also coming back to groups from the Region is the decision to eliminate the liaison for BOD and the CAC odd and Even positions. There is a motion on the floor to revisit this. There is a compromise to expand the existing role of the LSRSC BOD representative.

There will be a regional inventory done at the next region on Saturday. Anyone interested in being a part may come and participate in it.

Elections were held and there are still some positions open

Notetaker is open however Brittany B was appointed to the position by the facilitator

Money handler is open; however, the current money handler will continue until someone steps up

Communication Liaison, Nicole N was appointed by facilitator

Outreach/PR is open.

# Regional Delegate Team Report May 2026

## **World Service Conference**

The World Service Conference was amazing. It was nice to put faces with names and be in person to experience the true reality of a WorldWide Fellowship. There were delegates from all over the world. The conference voted in Afghanistan and Brazil this cycle. This WSC added two more regions to the WSC. The following decisions were made at the WSC:

CAR REPORT

1. Approve the revised IP#21, *Staying Clean in Isolation*, contained in Addendum A, as Fellowship-approved recovery literature to replace the current IP#21, *The Loner- Staying Clean in Isolation*.(World Board)
  - a. Initial Straw Poll 130 Yes, 1 No, 0 Abstain, 0 Present Not Voting, 99.24% **Consensus Support**.
  
2. To adopt the collaboratively created 2026-2029 NA World Services Strategic Plan contained in Addendum B. (World Board)
  - a. Initial Straw Poll: 122 Yes, 4 No, 4 Abstain, 1 Present Not Voting; 93.85% **Consensus Support**
  
3. Motion 3 Amendments
  - a. 3.A.3 (German Speaking Region)
    - i. Consensus Not in Support **Amendment Fails**
  
  - b. 3.A.4 (Finland Region)
    - i. Initial Straw Poll: 44 Yes, 62 No, 17 Abstain, 8 Present Not Voting. 77% Lack of Strong Support
  
    - ii. Second Straw Poll: 42 Yes, 77 No, 6 Abstain, 5 Present Not Voting. 33.60% Lack of Strong Support.

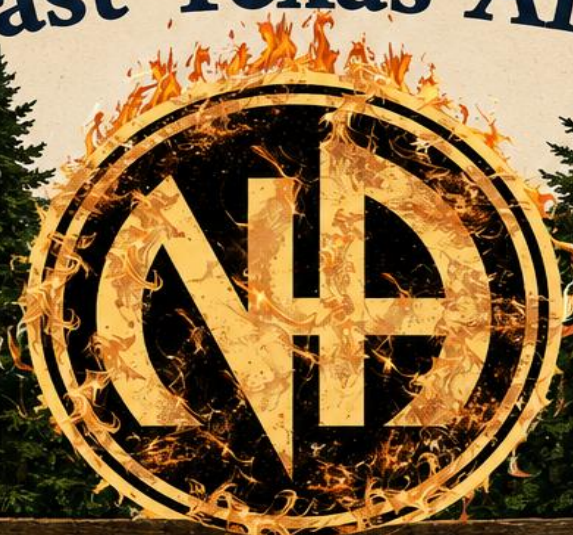
